Beginner Umpire Courses:

Aim: To introduce the rudiments of umpiring a netball match junior or inexperienced players in club or school environment.

Outcomes:

- To have knowledge of basic rules of the game.
- To identify obvious infringements of the rules.
- To apply correct use of voice, whistle and terminology.
- To be aware of correct positioning.
- To keep an accurate scorecard and call the score.

- To identify the requirements for the England Netball Beginner Award.
- Prepare candidates for assessment/test.

C Award courses:

Aim: To prepare umpires with knowledge of rules and umpires competencies to umpire at average adult club level.

Outcomes:

To be able to apply the rules and control the game by:

- penalising correctly obvious infringements of the rules.
- correct use of whistle, voice and terminology.
- positioning and movement.
- appearance and manner.
- keep a correct scorecard and call the score.
- To identify the requirements for the FENA C Award to include competencies.
- To prepare candidates for assessment/test.
